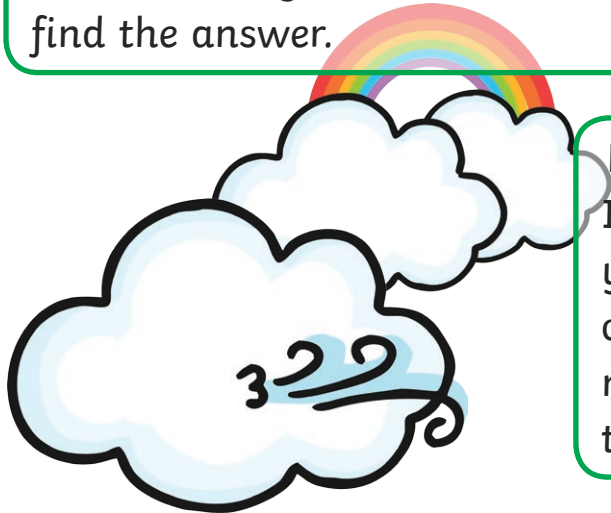


EYFS Weather

Home Learning Challenges



On a sunny day, we sometimes hang our washing on the line for the sun to dry. If you had 3 T-shirts hanging on the washing line and 1 skirt, how many things would there be altogether? Draw the washing to find the answer.



Pour a little pile of flour onto the table. Imagine that the flour is snow. What would you like to do in the snow? Spread the snow out on the table with your hands. Can you make patterns in the snow? Can you write the first letter of your name?

Can you feel the wind blowing? Hold a piece of ribbon or a scarf in your hand and stand outside. Can you see it moving in the wind? Is it moving a little bit or a lot? Look around you. Can you see the wind blowing the trees or anything else?



The next time it rains, go out puddle jumping with a grown-up. Put on your wellies and jump in the puddles. What words would you use to describe the puddles? What sounds can you hear when you jump in them?
